- Since 1990 In Finland
- Beginning of the school year
- A plan for the whole school year activities that increase wellbeing at school and prevent bullying (students and adults)





Peer Support

Peer supporters are ordinary students in grades 8 and 9 who volunteer to work for other students at their school in order to create a safe and friendly school atmosphere.

The Aims of the Scheme

- Promotion of considerate behaviour
- Promotion of young people's participation
- Proactive prevention of conflicts and bullying
- Personal growth



First two days at school for grade 7



Practices in Bullying Intervention

Step one:

Discussion with student, classroom teacher, social worker, parents (teasing, bad behaviour)

Step two:

Discussion with **KiVa team** members, parents (bullying)

Step three:

Meeting at school with multiprofessional group

Ideas for Improvement

The new curricula 2016 emphasises:

- Phenomenon-based learning alongside subject-based learning (= integration of subjects)
 - Emphasis on community and learning and growing together (both teachers and students)
- Learning environments outside school
 The joy of learning, <u>no bullying!</u>

A need: reference group for lonely and depressed girls

<u>DISA</u> (Depression in Swedish Adolescents)

- A method how to deal with negative thoughts among teenage girls
- exercises to increase the amount of healthy activities
- exercises in communication and problem solving activities
- exercises in enhancing social skills and building social networks

Folkhälsan: Tjejgrupp (group for girls)

- To increase self-esteem for girls
- Functions during free time volunteers
